CERD Shadow Reporting: Tentative Timeline

October 2006	Ralph F. Boyd Jr. resigns from CERD committee and replaced by Pierre-Richard Prosper, the former United States Ambassador-at-Large for War Crimes and previous US Attorney.
April 2007	US State Department releases second periodic compliance report to CERD Committee
June-Dec 2007	National CERD trainings around the United States*
Aug-Oct 2007	Submission of information to National CERD Shadow Report Working Groups**
Dec 2007	Submission of shadow reports to CERD Committee. Lobbying of CERD Committee members and organizing for Geneva
Feb-March 2008	United States on the CERD Committee calendar for review by CERD Committee
Spring 2008	Community Report Back on US Review by CERD Committee
Summer/Fall 2008	CERD Committee releases Concluding Comments
Fall 2008	Follow-up meetings on Concluding Comments
